Security Deposit & Expense Account for all academic courses there is a deposit of £1,750 which is payable with the first term's fees. This consists of a £750 refundable damage deposit and a £1,000 expenses deposit. The expenses deposit is used for additional costs, such as taxis, textbooks (from £10-£30), IELTS examinations (from £160-£260), other external examinations (from £60-£200), extra excursions (from £5 for group excursions to £50 for individual excursions), and so on. Costs listed are not set by the college and may change. The remaining balance is refunded four weeks after the end of the course. For courses over 1 year, a deposit of £5,500 is required towards the final term of study.

January Entry Courses include extra catch-up classes provided at no extra cost, as required.

Students are able to reside on campus during half terms at a cost of £250 per half term.

Instalments - The deadline for full payments in instalments are as follows:

One instalment: 30th August 2025 for September Entry, or 30th December 2025 for January Entry.

Two instalments: 30th August 2025 & 30th December 2025 for September Entry.

Deposit - Please note that a £50 deposit is required upon arrival. This is refundable if no damages or losses have occurred. Courses start and finish every Sunday.

Airport Transfers for All Courses

Shared transfers: **Academic courses:** for flights arriving/departing 10:00 - 17:00 **only** to/from London Heathrow on the Travel Day (see below) shared transfers are provided **free of charge**.

Summer courses: for flights arriving/departing 10:00 - 17:00 **only** to/from London Heathrow every Sunday between the course dates below, shared transfers provided at a cost of **£140 each way**.

Academic English courses: we do not provide shared transfers. You will need to book a direct transfer. There will be some waiting time for other arrivals/departures.
